What is an MCT?

We offer training courses in the latest skills, focusing on technologies such as Microsoft365, Power Platform, and Azure.

Microsoft Certified Trainer is a worldwide certification that recognizes practical skills and broad knowledge.

In addition to supporting the trainer's skill development, promotions, and career changes, it is also a valuable asset to the trainer's company.



MCT's Activities

Up until now, not much has been known about MCTs in Japan or their activities.

This is because MCTs are usually on the teaching side in a learning environment, and most people in Japan might just assume they are some type of teacher working at a computer technical school.

MCTs are active in a variety of places, sometimes training corporate employees, and other times freelance, conducting training at small and medium-sized companies.



It is natural then that companies have doubts about whether they need MCTs.

Just as it is believed that "things are best left to experts in their field," so is the role of the MCT, an instructor who fosters experts in their field, and this is the role of the MCT, which fosters certified professionals.

It is also the only event where those who are not familiar with MCTs can understand what the MCT Program is all about.

This event is organized directly by MCTs themselves, and is partially sponsored and supported by Microsoft Headquarters.



About MCT SUMMIT JAPAN 2024

This is the first summit for Microsoft Certified Trainers to be held in Asia.

Along with Microsoft Certified Trainers, the event will also be attended by people hoping to become new MCTs, MCT alumni, and companies invested in the skilling and certification space.

The following themes are planned for MCT SUMMIT JAPAN 2024.

Theme 1: Use of AI and Copilot

Copilot is an AI assistant developed by Microsoft.

Although Microsoft has held seminars and events for enterprises, many still have questions about Copilot.

Therefore, one of our themes we will encourage speakers to present on is Copilot- ranging from "Copilot for Microsoft 365" to "Copilot for Sales" to "Copilot for Security", etc. All Copilot skills will promote new ways of work for companies.

Theme 2: What is an MCT?

Do you know what a Microsoft Certified Trainer is?

A certified trainer is a person who is familiar with Microsoft products and has the ability to teach those products.

In addition to certified trainers employed by a company, there are also certified trainers who work on a freelance basis, and their activities vary. Since some of you may or may not know about us certified trainers, we will again provide you with more information.

Some sessions will be open to the public, allowing anyone to participate. Some other sessions will only be open to current MCTs.

Theme 3: From Japan to Asia-and from Asia to the World!

MCTs often get certified and then wonder "How can I try to find work" or "What are other MCTs doing?"

For this theme, we encourage sessions about how to utilize tools for MCTs to follow up and solve such "problems" and how to grow a network for training.

Timeline

The event is scheduled to be held on November 8th and 9th 2024. Detailed dates and times will be announced as soon as they are finalized, as speakers and other details are being coordinated.
